



# How to measure for a Waistcoat

## Chest -

Lift your arms and get a second person to stand in front of you to take the sizes. The tape measure is to go under your armpits, around your shoulder blades and over the widest part of your chest. This is usually the nipple line. This measurement should be firm but so you can slide the tape measure from side to side.

If these are a slim fit garment and you have a tummy that is more prominent than your chest, we would always recommend purchasing the next size up to ensure you can fasten your waistcoat around your waist. For example, your chest is 38" but to accommodate your tummy, you should order the 40". We would also recommend this for those wanting a looser fit.

## Length

As a general rule for waistcoat length, we recommend the below guide. If you prefer to have your waistcoat length a little longer, just order the next length up.

Your Height	W/C Length
5'4" - 5'7"	Short (S)
5'7.5" - 5'11"	Regular (R)
5'11.5" - 6'2.5"	Long (L)

## Nested Suit

Please note if buying a nested suit, this means that the suit comes as a 3 piece set. In this scenario, you would order from the jacket size and receive the trouser that is 6" slimmer than the jacket chest size. If you order a 38R jacket you would receive the 38R waistcoat and 32R trousers. Please see our our guide on nested suits.
